About Oslo

- We focused on three districts in Oslo with a joint population of almost 140 000.
- The districts have diverse neighborhoods; from downtown apartments and blocks of flats to detached houses in areas with large green spaces and access to unspoiled nature.
- Some of the neighborhoods struggle with a negative image with regards to poverty, congested living conditions and crime.

STUDENT RESEARCH

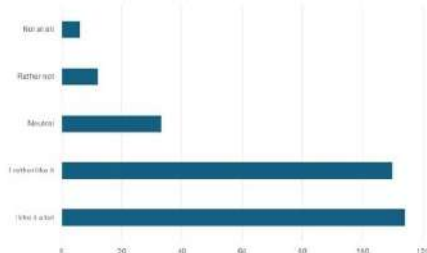
- Focus on the districts of Søndre Nordstrand, Bjerke and Grünerløkka.

Interviewed 275 residents

- 74% born in Norway
- 45% 1 parent born outside EU

81% likes living in their neighborhood.

Do you like living in this neighborhood?

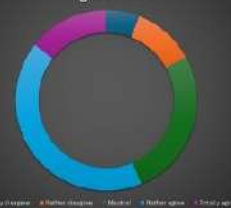


Is this a good neighborhood for children to grow up?

I feel connected to people in this neighborhood

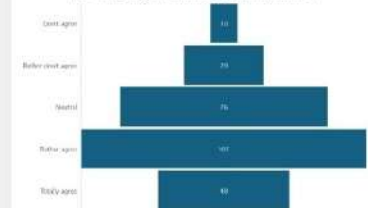


56% feels connected to other residents.

3 out of 10 experience a lack of places to meet likeminded people

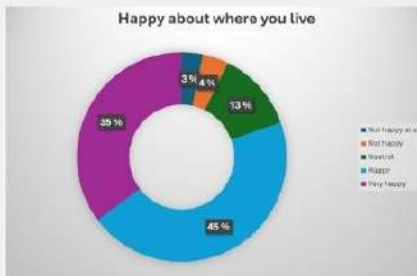
It is easy to get to know new people here?



Is this a good neighborhood for older people?

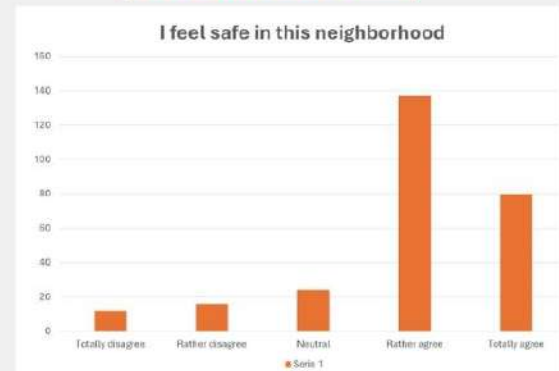
