Whats is an IP?

- Intensive and short-term training
- International and multidisciplinary participation
- Practical and collaborative approach



Main Objectives of an IP

- Promote curriculum internationalization
- Encourage collaborative work
- Apply knowledge to real-life situations
- Develop intercultural competencies



Planning an IP

- Choice of relevant and interdisciplinary topic
- Structure: 5 inperson days+ prior work
- Active methodology
- International teaching coordination



Methodology of the IP

- Experiential and participatory approach
- Project based and research based learning
- Work in international groups
- Both in person and virtual activities



Structure of the IP

- Location: Host university
- Format: Lectures, workshops, field visits, research labs, etc...



Sample Agenda

- Day 1: Welcome, introductions, theoretical framework
- Day 2-3: Visits to social institutions
- Day 4: Data analysis /group reflections
- Day 5: Presentation of results/evaluation



Coordination and Roles of Universities

- Coordinating university: leadership and management tasks
- Partner universities: content organization, thematic contributions, student mobilization
- Mixed european teaching team



Selection of Student Participants

- Selection criteria: level, motivation, language skills, experience
- Number of participants per university (5 students per university)
- Inclusion and diversity



Funding and Logistical Support

- Erasmus + Movility funds
- Accommodations, transport and meals
- Language and cultural support



Evaluation and Expected Results

- Assessment of acquired competencias
- Evaluation of the IP (feedback, surveys)
- Certification and credits
- Dissemination of results



Dissemination of Results

- Final presentations
- Academic publications
- Social media, institutional press
- Multipliers events



Key to Success

- Clear communication
- Flexibility
- Student well-being
- Coherence between objectives and activities



Sustainability and Continuity

- Integration of the programme into university curricula
- Replability in other faculties or academic years
- Creation of research networks
